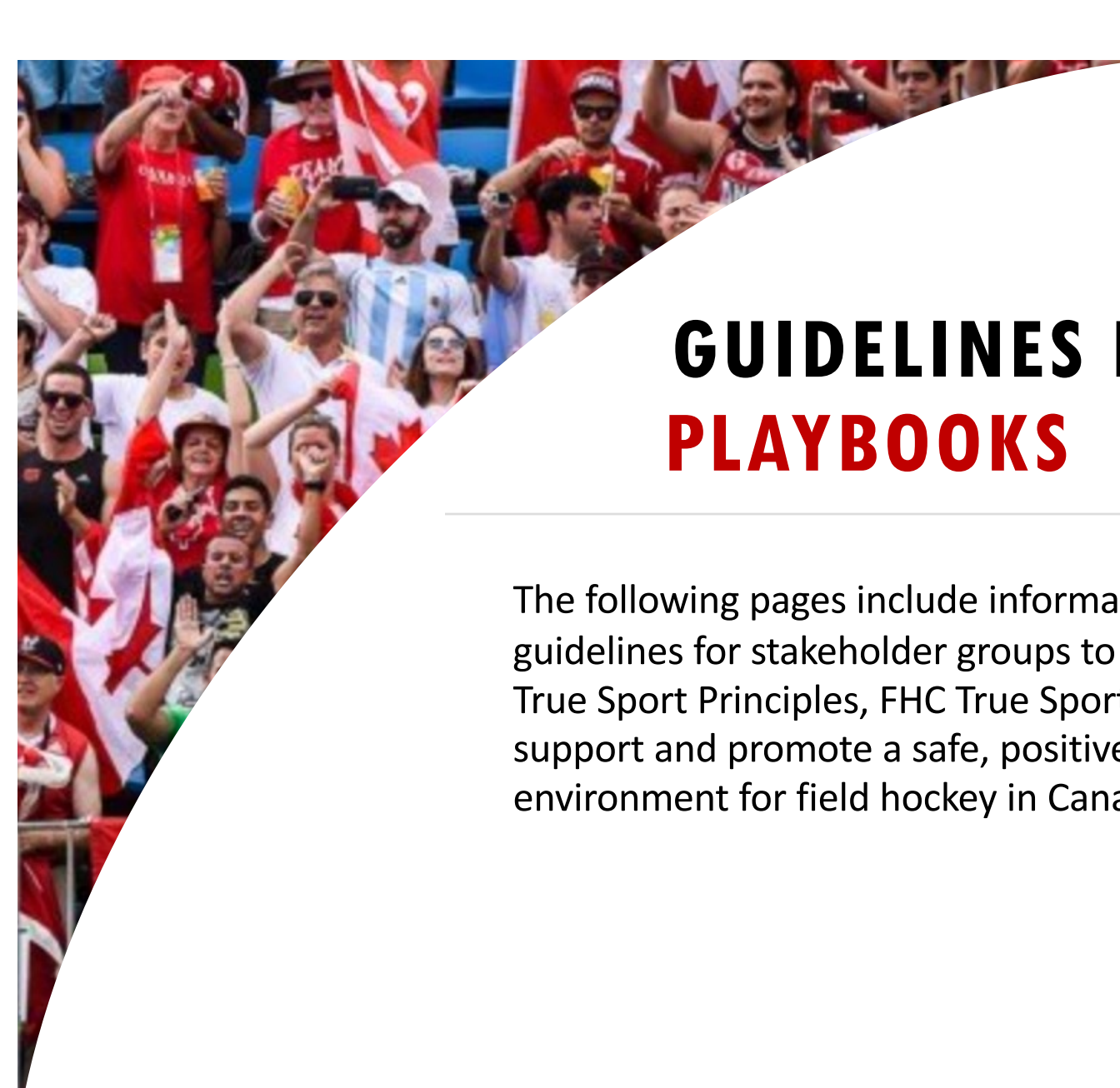




GUIDELINES FOR ACTION PLAYBOOKS

FHC LEADERSHIP + OFFICE – ACTIONS

The True Sport Principles are the expressed commitment by FIELD HOCKEY CANADA to ensure a safe, inclusive, welcoming and positive environment for athletes, supported by coaches, parents, officials and administrators. We believe that adhering to these field of play principles will encourage an optimal sport environment for all participants.

Field Hockey in Canada will benefit from aligning with other sport organizations who also believe in and are promoting these principles.

- Share portions of the True Sport Framework and framework concepts or initiatives each week during the Monday staff meetings.
- Recognize True Sport behaviours in office/on field/over media
- Celebrate members and partners that embody the True Sport Values and principles
- Develop a True Sport Award for National Championships: to be handed out along side the Tournament XI at the end of the event to the individual that demonstrated sportsmanship, leadership, and alignment with true sport principles.

- Incorporate True Sport principles and education into the “Ahead of The Game” Webinar Series and FHC Conference Materials.
- Incorporate True Sport Framework and principles actively in the interview processes for staff, coaches and board members.
- Add ‘activating True Sport’ as a core competency to be evaluated by staff: In what ways are you intentionally bringing True Sport to life in your department as a reflection of your commitment to walking the talk with respect to FHC’s culture and values.
- Develop a Webinar Education session for FHC Staff, PSO’s and Board Members to teach the True Sport Framework and share True Sport Initiatives
- Every time the name of a participant is mentioned in articles, media or announcements the communication should include reference to the participants club and PSO ie. Name (Club, Province).



PSO + CLUB ORGANIZATIONS – ACTIONS

- Strive for balanced gender representation across staff, board and contract positions.
- Actively seek out a greater diversity of perspectives, knowledge, experience, skills and backgrounds thereby adding richness to discussions and increasing creativity and innovation in problem solving;
- Use the True Sport Principles, FHC True Sport Framework and actively provide programming that encourages the participation of girls and women in the sport. Generate a positive environment for the participation of women and girls.
- Provide gender-friendly programming and coaching, avoiding gender stereotypes and creating a positive and social atmosphere;
- Ensure your organization is sensitive to a wider range of potential participants, some of whom may have been excluded in the past.
- Consider the addition of inclusive / para and Special Olympic sport options.
- Consider the addition of Indigenous programming.
- Look for ways to retain athletes once they retire. Consider asking athletes questions related to the True Sport Principles during their exit interviews.

- Consider identifying your field of play and facilities as True Sport Facilities,
- Identify your True Sport Facilities with appropriate signage – available through the FHC True Sport Website: <https://fieldhockey.ca/safe-sport/true-sport/>
- Monitor and evaluate how well the True Sport Principles are being lived on the field of play through membership surveys and by engaging athletes, coaches and families.
- Actively share, promote and celebrate True Sport Framework principles and key focus areas by engaging with and sharing FHC media, resources and outreach within your club or organization.

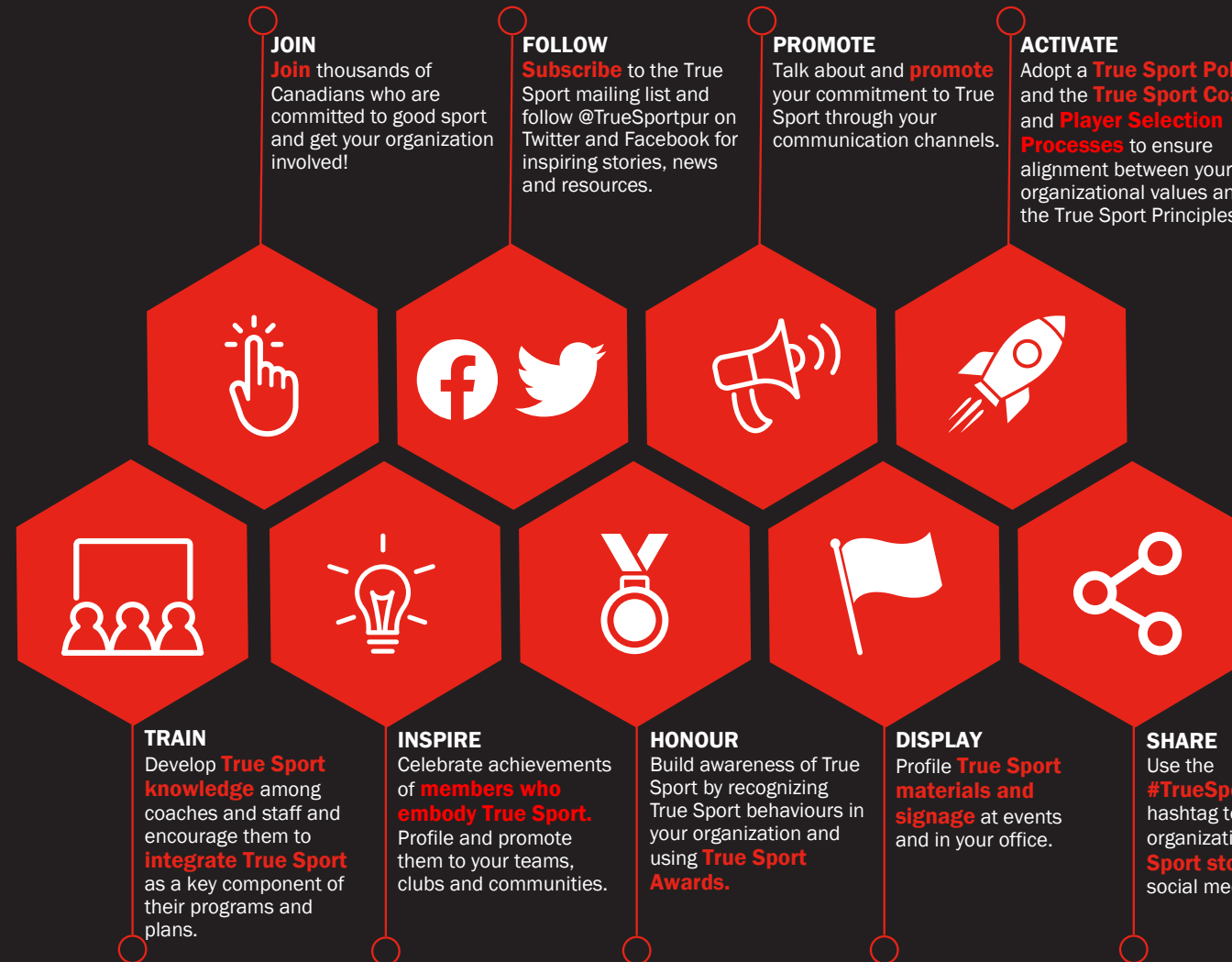

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ATHLETES AND NATIONAL TEAMS— ACTIONS

There are a number of ways that Athletes and Teams can engage with True Sport and help to support and build a positive sport culture for field hockey in Canada.

- All Athletes over 16 should take the FHC Community Coach Training module and volunteer time in your clubs and communities teaching and mentoring young field hockey athletes as an introduction to our sport
- Senior Athletes should take Competition Development stream coach education, and work with your PSO's to support developmental and provincial athletes in training.
- Along with the True Sport Value, Give Back. Athletes and Teams should participate in regular Volunteer hours within the FH community. This could include outreach/program support / coaching at camps, supporting event hosting, speaking to groups of young athletes or students and more.
- National Teams should consider having True Sport Athlete Ambassadors to lead True Sport initiatives and encourage cultural development around True Sport Principles.
- Be aware of policy, resources and process around concussion and return to play guidelines.
- Be aware of policy, resources and process regarding Anti-Doping, and clean sport.
- Be aware of available resources with regard to health and wellness and seek support when needed.
- Work with Field Hockey Canada, your Provincial Organization and Club to inspire young athletes, model positive behaviours and support principles and initiatives included in the FHC True Sport Framework.

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COACHES – ACTIONS

Coaches are the front line ambassadors of delivering field hockey experiences that align with FHC's organizational values of Integrity, Fun, Accountability, Teamwork, Respect and Transparency. It is only through dedicated coaches that we can continue to grow our game and develop our culture by living the True Sport Principles.

- **Coaches**– All coaches should consider declaring their commitment to True Sport

- Coaches can promote and share the ways they bring the True Sport Principles to life in their training environments.
- Coaches should be aware of gender equity on and off the field, and work to provide safe and welcoming environments.
- Coaches should seek out new and innovative approaches to coaching, training, performance management
- Coaches should be aware of recruitment and retention of all sport participants, make field hockey accessible to all communities and prioritize the enjoyment and satisfaction of players over winning.
- Review and educate yourselves on the [True Sport Player Selection Process](#) as well as the [True Sport Coach Selection Process](#) and adapt or customize for your needs.
- Coaches have a responsibility to become qualified and should actively pursue education, evaluation and mentorship opportunities.
- Coaches should become familiar with the Responsible Coaching Movement, Rule of Two and Safe Sport Processes.

OFFICIALS – ACTIONS

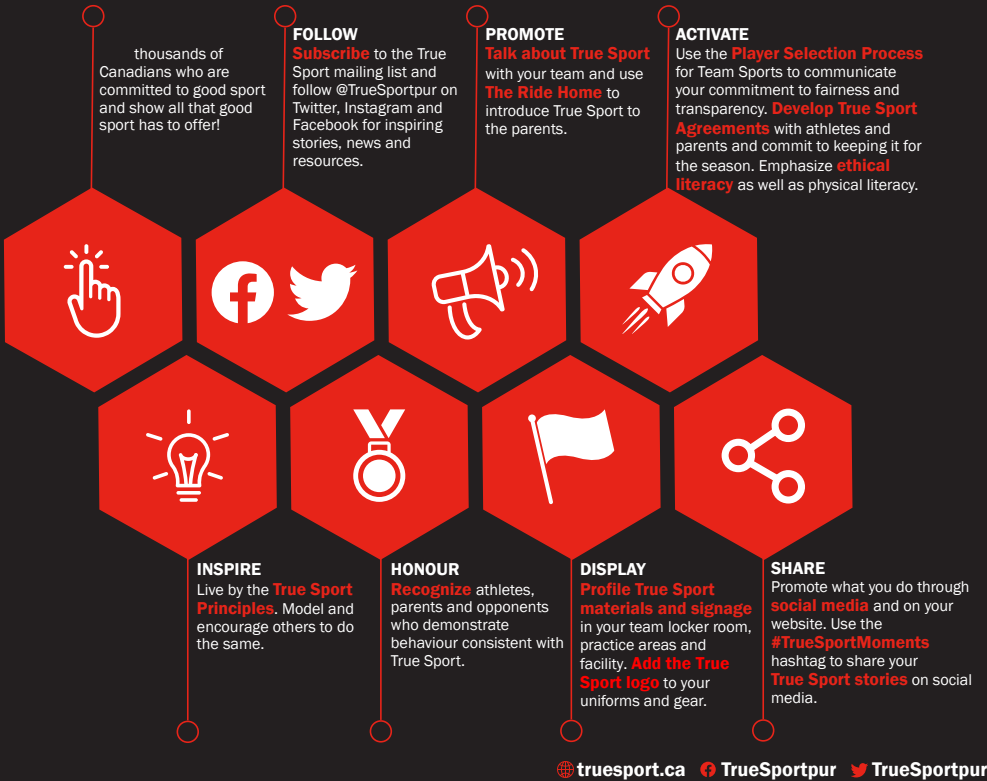
We recognize that without umpires, the game of field hockey cannot grow.

- **Officials**– All officials should consider declaring their commitment to True Sport <https://truesportpur.ca/member-types>
- Officials have a responsibility to help facilitate games that are safe for all participants.
- Officials should be aware of and promote True Sport Principles, and the key items and pillars associated with the FHC True Sport Framework.
- Officials should be aware of recruitment and retention of new umpires and officials and make training and mentorship accessible to diverse and inclusive communities.

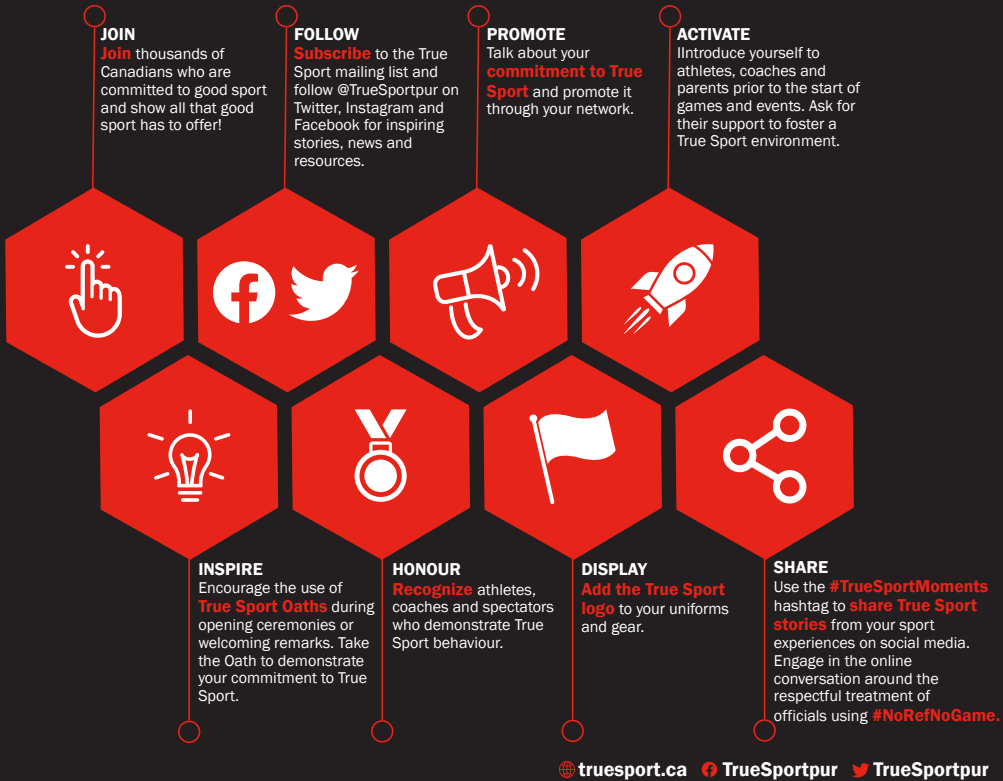
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EVENTS + FACILITIES – ACTIONS

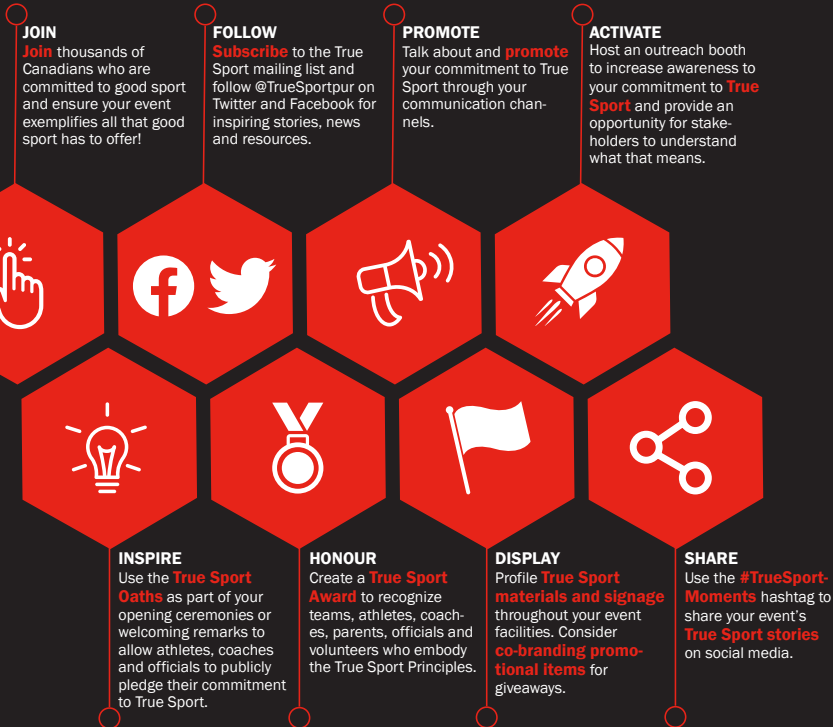
All facilities supporting field hockey programming, as well as hosted events, leagues and tournaments could be declared True Sport events. The following actions could be taken to use the True Sport Principles and FHC True Sport Framework key focus areas to promote the development of a positive sport culture

- **True Sport Facilities** – All FHC Partner clubs + Facilities should be registered with True Sport <https://truesportpur.ca/member-types>
- Facilities should have posted signage. True Sport + FHC Branded signage templates are available on the website <https://fieldhockey.ca/safe-sport/true-sport/>
- Display with True Sport principles and FHC Commitments in event programs.
- Consider displaying the True Sport logos during major events on the field of play/uniforms/banners as a reminder of the environment you are intentionally creating. <https://truesportpur.ca/field-play> or <https://truesportpur.ca/examples-equipment-and-uniforms>
- Consider using True Sport oaths in the opening ceremonies
- Consider Nomination of a [True Sport athlete](#) from each contingent. (National Championships and/or other tournament events)
- Develop a True Sport Award for events which could be handed out along side the Tournament XI at the end of the event to the individual that demonstrated sportsmanship, leadership, and alignment with true sport principles. <https://truesportpur.ca/true-sport-award>

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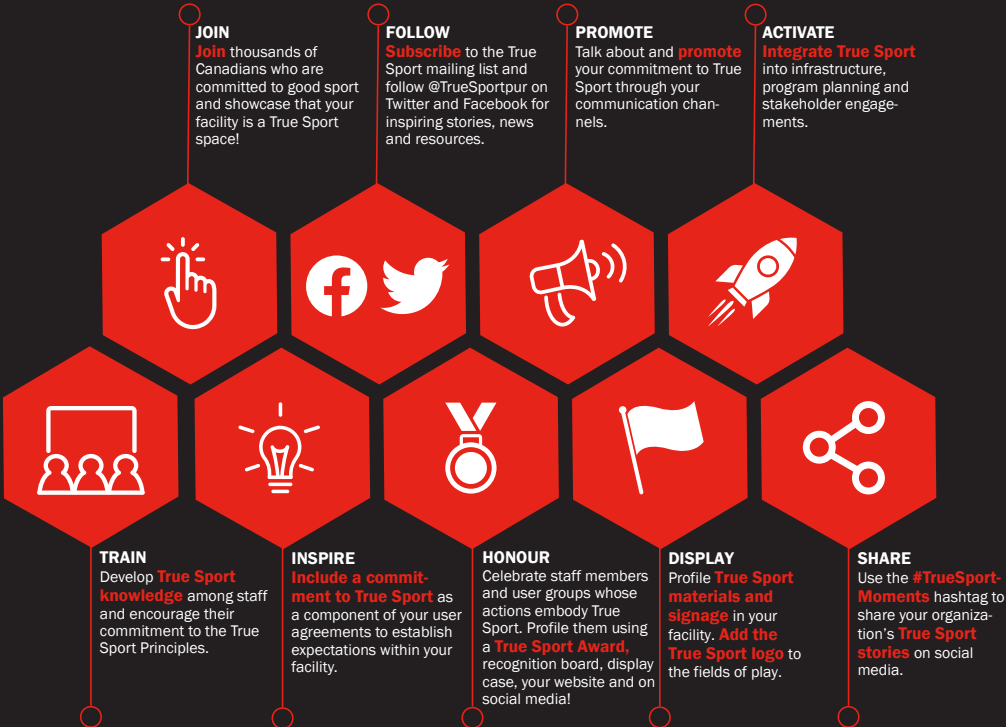


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
