Directions to Field from Nearest Intersection	From King George Boulevard • Turn west onto 64 Avenue • Turn right (north) into carpark • Call person will meet ambulance in carpark	From highway 99 • Continue southbound on highway 99 • Take exit 16 for highway 91 North • Take exit 1 for highway 10 east • Turn left (north) onto 120 street/Scott Road • Turn right (east) onto 64th avenue • Turn left (north) into car park • Call person will meet ambulance in carpark
Emergency Response Protocol		• Limit scene to First Aid providers and move by-standers and players away from the area. • When calling Emergency Services, provide name and title or position, current address, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as requested. • Contact First Aid providers through the EMERGENCY CALL PERSON.

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On Site Charge Person[s] - o Clear the risk of further harm to the injured person by securing the area and shelter the injured person from the elements - o Designate who is in charge of the other participants - o Protect yourself [wear gloves if in contact with body fluid such as blood] - o Assess ABCs [checks airway is clear, breathing is present, a pulse present, no major bleeding] - o Wait by injured person until EMS arrives and the injured person is transported	21 July: Alice Podmore (AM) / Tristan Sandhu (PM) 22 July: Alice Podmore (AM) / 23 July: Alice Podmore 24 July: Alice Podmore (AM) / Luisa Ribeiro (PM) 25 July: Alice Podmore 26 July: Luisa Ribeiro
On Site Call Person - o Call for Emergency Help - o Provide all necessary information to dispatch [e.g. facility, location, nature of injury, what if any first aid has been done] - o Clear any traffic from the entrance/access road before ambulance arrives - o Wait by the carpark to direct the ambulance when it arrives	Option 1: Secondary medical staff Option 2: Hailey Yhap Option 3: Tournament Staff
Emergency Services Phone number	911
AED Location	Stored in national team bin, during tournament will be located in the medical tent
Assembly Point for Lightning or Severe weather	Take shelter immediately in any surrounding building or metal-roofed vehicle. Stay inside for 20 minutes after the timing between thunder and lightning has extended to more than 20 seconds.
Muster Point	In events of a mass emergency such as an earthquake, the assembly point for all staff and attendees is

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
